

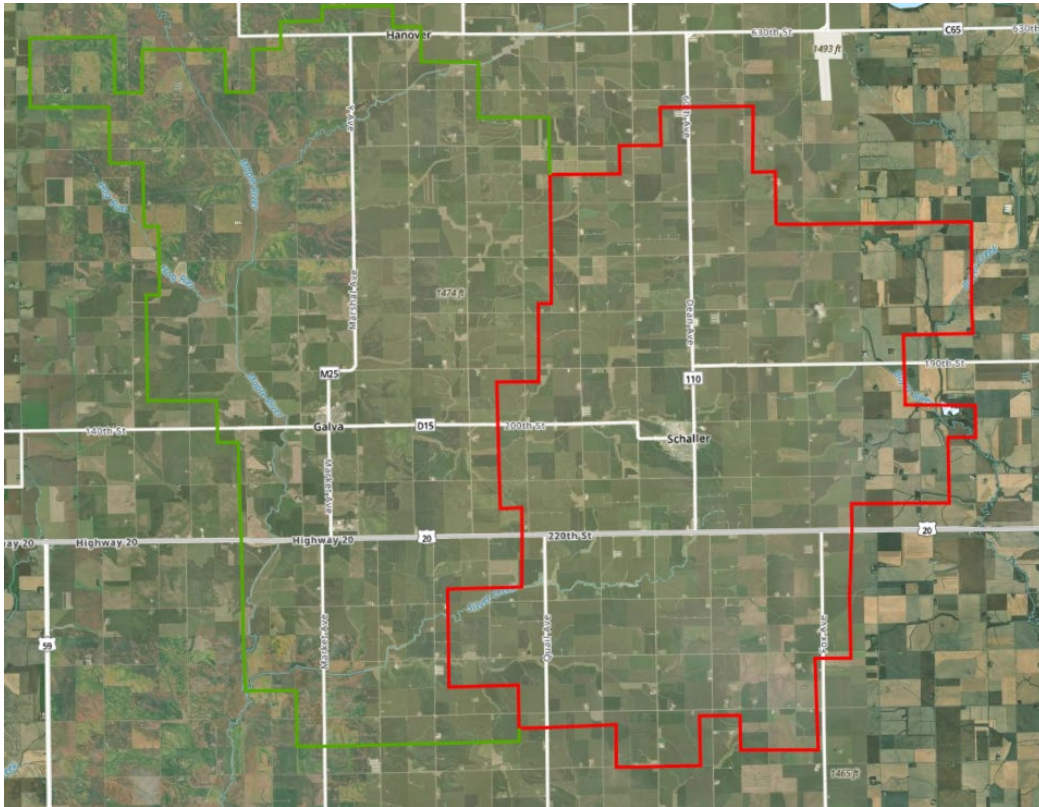
Schaller Telephone Company Scholarship

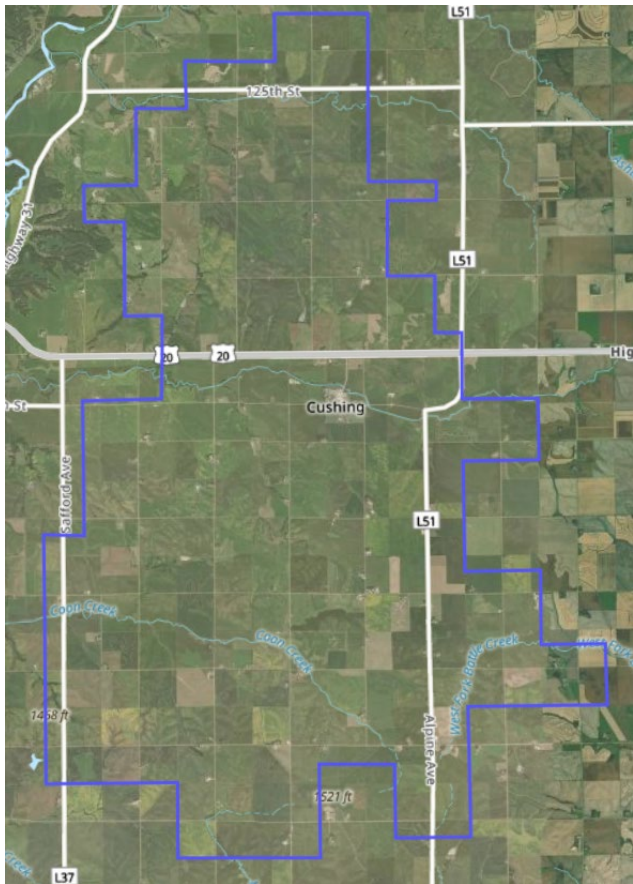

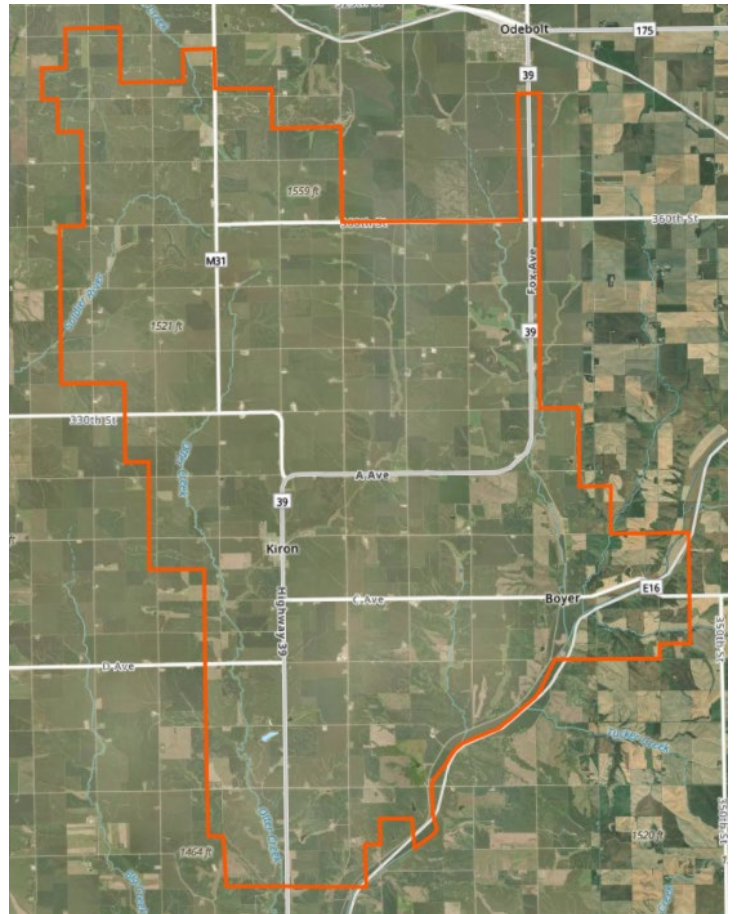
Galva Exchange Boundary & Schaller Exchange Boundary
