Eligibility

- High School Senior
- Reside In and Attend a High School in a Membership Community of the Northwest Iowa League of Cities

Criteria

- Enrolled in a program that may result in employment by city government (examples: public administration, water/wastewater, law enforcement, code enforcement, planner, public engineer, etc.).
- Enrolled in a post-secondary institution (community college, 4 year college, university, or trade school).

Scholarship Application Requirements

(All Steps Required)

- Complete and return the application form provide (see attached).
- Submit a 400-500 word essay about why the applicant is interested in city government.
